The Ohio Rehabilitation Services Commission (ORSC) announces the availability of the TG Public Benefit Award for the 2008-09 academic year. ORSC will award a minimum of 25 \$2,000 awards which are designed to promote the retention of students with disabilities of institutions of higher education in Ohio.

Eligible applicants are:

- Students who have open postsecondary training cases with ORSC (may be either BVR or BSVI consumers)
- The award is open to consumers who are currently enrolled in any class status at a postsecondary institution and who will be pursuing a postsecondary education in the next 12 months. Applicants may be attending a proprietary school, vocational school, technical school, community college or four year college or university. Students must be attending postsecondary institution in Ohio.
- Eligible applicants must have a minimum 2.8 cumulative grade point average.

Applicants will be accepted by postal mail, via e-mail or by fax. Applicant is responsible for ensuring the application packet is complete. Applications are to be postmarked by May 1, 2008.
